PETITION

(Moved under Rule 30 of the Rules of Procedure)

THE HUMBLE PETITION by more than five hundred vendors operating in Soroti City Market, presented by **Hon. Acom Joan Aloba**, District Woman Representative, Soroti City.

SHOWETH AND STATES THAT-

1. Your humble petitioners are vendors operating in Soroti City Market, a market constructed by the Government of Uganda under the Markets and Agricultural Trade Improvement Program (MATIP 2);
2. Your petitioners are aggrieved by the interference in the allocation of stalls and lock-ups in Soroti City Market by some political leaders and technical staff in the City leading to the exclusion of the bona-fide market vendors from the allocation process;
3. Your humble petitioners aver that-
 - (a) Soroti City Market is one of the markets constructed by the Government of Uganda with the aim of reducing poverty through the enhancement of commercialization of agricultural produce;
 - (b) upon completion of the construction of the market in 2020, Government, through the Ministry of Trade and Tourism, provided guidelines for the operation of the market including; forming an Allocations Committee which would work, in collaboration with the city authorities to ensure smooth allocation of lock-ups and trade order;

- (c) the city authorities, including the Principal Community Development Officer, the City Clerk, Office of the Mayor and the Resident City Commissioner have interfered in the lock-ups and stalls allocation processes by-
- (i) disregarding and flouting the allocation procedures and guidelines issued by the Ministry of Trade and Tourism;
 - (ii) irregularly and illegally usurping the powers and mandate of the Allocations Committee to allocate stalls and lock-ups to persons who are not eligible for allocation of lock ups and stalls;
 - (iii) failing to provide leadership and resolve disputes that emerge and instead, connive with other city authorities to disfranchise bona-fide lock up and stalls owners;
 - (iv) refusing to issue allocation letters and execute tenancy agreements with vendors allocated market stalls and lock-ups, making it impossible to prove ownership of stalls and lock-ups and affecting their security of tenancy;
- (d) Your humble petitioners further aver that as a result of interference with the allocation process by city authorities, trade order has been adversely affected and as a result, vendors face a number of challenges, including-
- (i) illegal arrest and detention, extortion and bribery, high market dues and rates, threats and intimidation, unwarranted eviction;
 - (ii) lack of a streamlined trusted market vendor-led-leadership;
 - (iii) lack of vendor consultation in the decision making processes;

- (iv) gross mismanagement of the operations of the market vendor's SACCO to the detriment of the vendors;

Your petitioners aver that interference with the market stalls and lock-up allocation process and the general mismanagement of Soroti City Market has negatively affected trade order in the market and frustrated a noble Government program to the detriment of the people of Soroti City;

NOW, THEREFORE, your humble petitioners pray that -

- (a) the relevant Committee of Parliament investigates this matter and makes recommendations to the House;
- (b) Parliament directs the Auditor General to carry out a forensic audit on the management of Soroti City Market;

AND your humble Petitioners as in duty bound will ever pray;

AND hereto your humble Petitioners have appended their signatures.

SOROTI CITY MARKET VENDORS PETITION TO THE SPEAKER AND MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UGANDA.

THROUGH THE WOMAN MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT, SOROTI CITY.

Right Honorable Speaker and
Honorable Members of Parliament,



1.0. Preamble

This petition is presented to you on behalf of the aggrieved, threatened and oppressed vendors doing business in Soroti City main market.

Rt. Hon. Speaker and hon. Members of parliament of the republic of Uganda Soroti city market is among the modern markets constructed by government of Uganda under MATIP 2. The purpose of this market is to improve business targeting the local vendors who are doing business in Soroti main market. The strategic location of this market in Soroti city now signifies the importance of our city to the economy of Teso. By extension, this means that its trickle-down effect must benefit not just Soroti city but also the entire districts that surround Soroti namely; Kumi, Ngora, Bukedea, Kaberamaido, Kalaki, Amuria, Katakwi, Serere and the country at large.

Rt. Hon. Speaker and hon. Members because of this importance this market serves, the government through the Ministry of Trade and Industry provided guidelines for the operation of the market giving vendors responsibility to organize and form a committee of all allocation of the lock ups and together with the city authorities negotiate affordable rates in order for fairness, transparency and manageable rates so that the objectives and goals of constructing a modern market are achieved.

* The committee was given guidelines to follow during allocation. Five categories of vendors to benefit from the stalls included. 1. The vendors who had constructed lockups on land leased by council. 2. The vendors who were allocated council built units on council land. 3. The vendors renting units from those with council allocated units. 4. The vendors renting units from those who built units on leased land from council. 5. The vendors who were sub rentees. The committee was given 21 working days to complete its task and provide its report with a full list of vendors who would be provided with allocation letters.

It's important for everyone, with you members of parliament occupying the driving seat in making sure that the giant market doesn't become a white elephant. There should be no reason whatsoever to fail the intended goals and objectives for the establishment of this gift of a

modern market to the ordinary Uganda vendors working. The city council and the market vendors would then sign tenancy agreements before any operations would begin.

Rt. Honorable Speaker and members of the august house, the constitution and other laws give you, Rt. Honorable speaker and members the right to intervene in any matter concerning the public for purpose of achieving peace, order, development and good governance of the country. And other than you no other person, body or association has powers to make any law, regulation or rule except under authority conferred by this august house.

2.0. Background

Rt. Honorable speaker and honorable members, the construction of Soroti modern market was completed in 2020 and started full operation in 2020/11/22. after commissioning by HE. The President Gen. Yoweri Kaguta Tibuhaburwa Museveni.

This modern market structures accommodates approximately 1300 vendors. The Market was opened to the general public and specifically to the stakeholders of the Soroti market on the 22nd November 2020 by His Excellence YTK Museveni.

The guidelines provided by the Ministry of Trade and Industry was to ensure smooth allocation, trade order and organized vendors under able leadership.

Rt. Honorable Speaker and Honorable members of parliament, as the concerned vendors, we want to thank the government of republic of Uganda and H E. Gen. Yoweri Tubuhaburwa Kaguta Museveni for his pragmatic and visionary leadership step in the direction of fighting poverty in Teso and Uganda generally. For we know as a matter of fact that this market was constructed out of the governments large goal of poverty eradication project which to help uplift the most ordinary traders get involved in the money market and fight poverty.

3.0. What is the problem?

Rt. Honorable speaker and members, because the procedures and guidelines were deliberately flaunted and any attempt to raise complaints are gaged, the vendors problems are dwindling of working capital, collapse of businesses and many risk being arrested for defaulting in loan payments, and violent confrontations These problems are occasioned by the following; hijacking of the role of the allocation committee, absence of allocation letters and tenancy agreements, unnecessary arrests of vendors, extortion and bribery, high rates of stalls, water and electricity, frequent lack of electricity in the market, threats and intimidation , unwarranted eviction of vendors among others.

These aforementioned challenges have become complete obstacle to achieving the intended objectives for which this giant structure was established and if unattended to can turn it to a white elephant.

1. THE ROLE OF THE ALLOCATION COMMITTEE WAS HIJACKED.

When the committee completed category 1 and 2, the PCDO deliberately halted the operations of the committee and eventually took over the role. The allocation committee failed to finish its work , subsequently it could not submit its report that would contain details of vendors. As a result of hijacking the process vendors do not have allocation and tenancy agreements setting in array of confusion in occupation. Attempts to petition the office of the RCC worsened and magnified the problem. The RCC also got involved in allocating stalls and throwing out bonafide occupants even after the commissioner of trade intervened.

2. OPERATION WITHOUT ALLOCATION LETTERS AND TENANCY AGREEMENTS.

Vendors have no allocation letters and tenancy agreements with the city authority.

Rt. Honorable speaker and honorable members allow me enumerate some of the issues that if not addressed promptly, urgently and with the wit, firmness it deserves, the good faith and intention of both H.E Gen. Yoweri Kaguta Museveni and government generally will be wasted:

a. Absence of streamlined trustable leadership in the market

The semblance of leadership in the market was last constituted way before 2013. So much has since taken place, we have not had any renewal of mandate. This condition has left the stakeholders disenchanted especially by the chairperson who now acts as a loner, takes decisions unilaterally and in the most dictatorial manner ever been. The loner chairperson with his handpicked executives operate as though they are above the law. Every evidence observable is that they are picking their orders elsewhere not on the mandate given to them by the vendors.

b. The legality of the market vendors' Association

The other issue of concern is the legal stand of the market vendors' association

c. The gross mismanagement of the market vendors SACCO

d. Concealment of critical information that would otherwise benefit the vendors of the market

- e. Interference, connivance and intimidation of outspoken vendors from security offices especially the office of Resident City Commissioner, PCDO, City Clerk and the mayor's office.

Rt. Honorable speaker and members of parliament, person occupying these offices, instead of facilitating and overseeing the process of allocation of stalls to rightful stakeholder have instead become roadblock to the process. They have used their offices to allocate stalls to their friends, relatives and agents.

- f. The failure to complete the allocation and double allocation of stalls to some persons

4.0. Our prayers

Rt. Honorable speaker and Honorable members of parliament; like the law dictum states, that justice must not only be done must be seen to be done, we wish to put forward our prayers that we think that if granted, properly and promptly implemented, the Soroti city will be able to reap more than everyone ever imagined from the existence of the Soroti city market and its vendors;

- a. Forensic audit be done immediately in the market
- b. Accounts audit on the accounts operation of the market SACCO also be carried out immediately and all signatories be made to account for any illegalities found
- c. Streamline the process of leadership by cause transparent election of leaders in the market
- d. Allow the allocation committee to complete the process of validation, registration and allocation of stalls to authenticated vendors.
- e. Audit and clarify legality of the market vendors' Association, trading on behalf of the vendors.
- f. Restrain offices of RCC, PCDO and others from interference, connivance and intimidation of vendors who are questioning their illegal actions.

5.0. Conclusion

Rt. Honorable speaker and Honorable members of parliament, we petition on those critical issues with unresolvable faith and trust in your capabilities office and roles. The issues in this market are reaching a very bad level but can still be redeemed and the best offices to handle and reverse this bad trend is you Rt. Honorable speaker and honorable members.

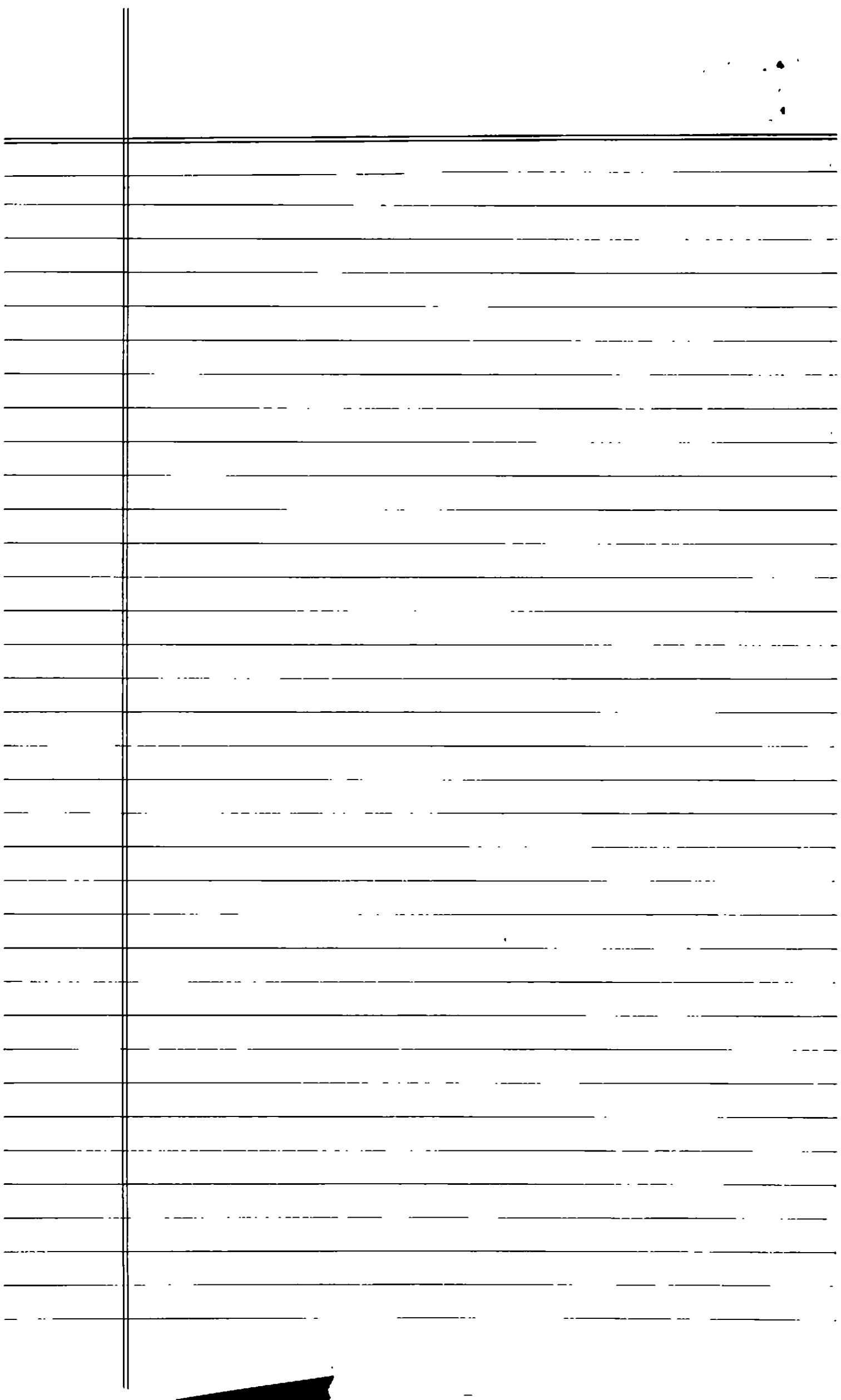

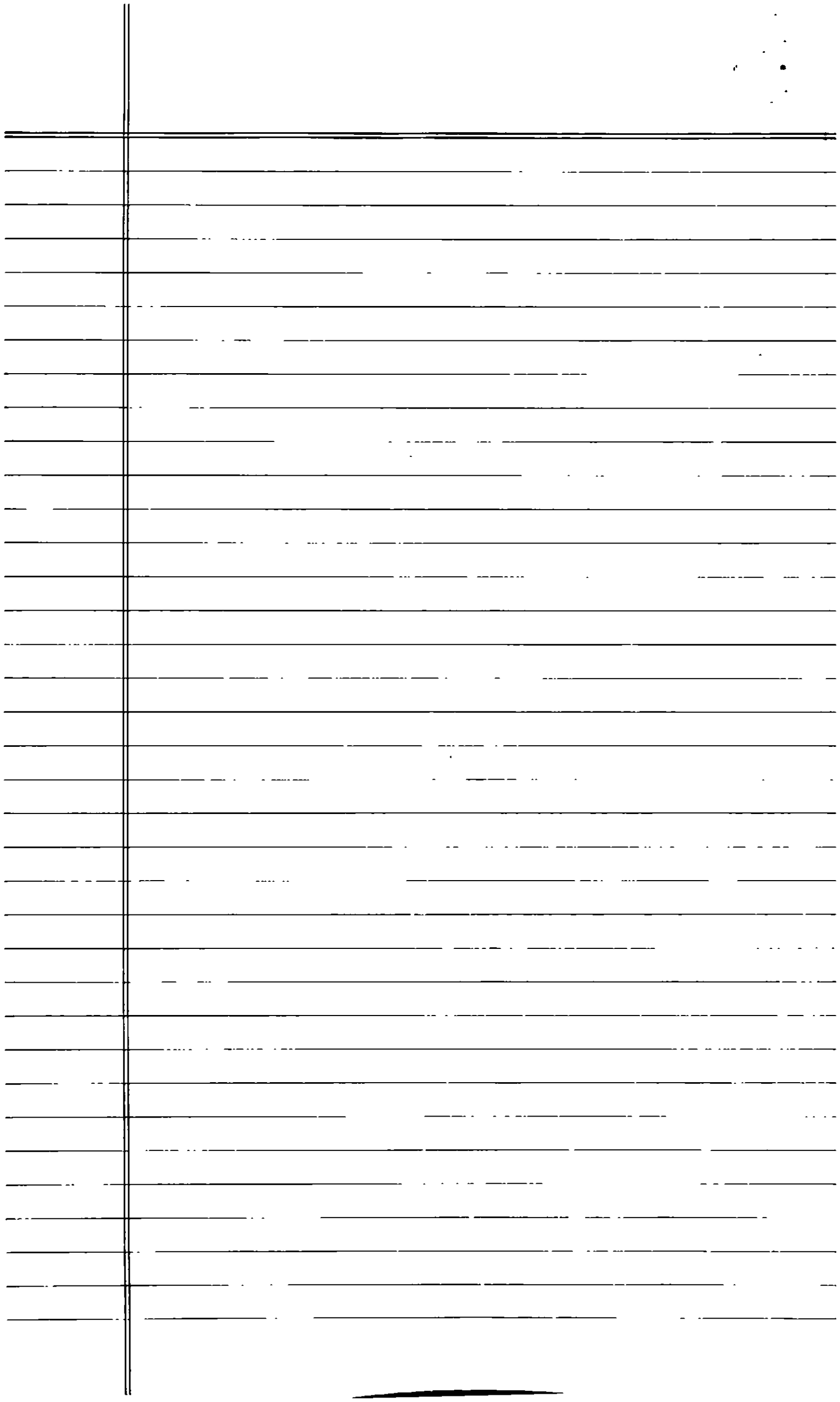

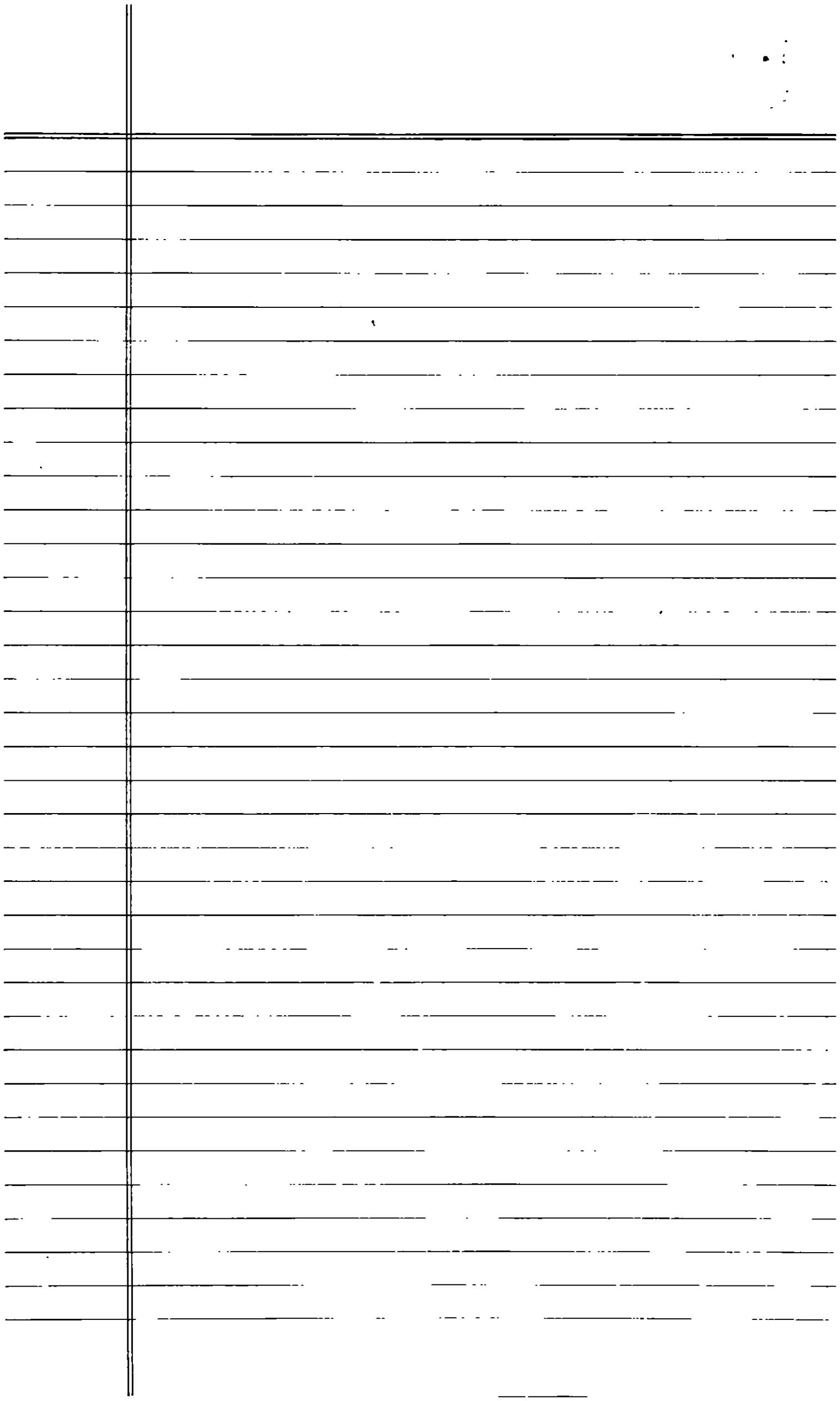
